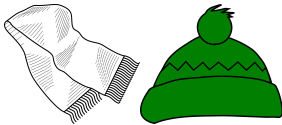
Mon. Feb. 8: **Journée du drapeau québécois**

- Students wear a toque and scarf of their choosing today.

Wed. Feb. 10: **Wacky Wednesday**



- Students wear their clothing inside-out, backwards or upside down, and accessorize with a bizarre, crazy, strange hat or wacky hairstyle.

- Students wear their favourite sports team jersey or shirt. Let's show our favourite athletes we support them!!!

Fri. Feb. 12: **Formal 'Valentine' Friday**
