**ST. JOHN XXIII CATHOLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN UNIONVILLE
IS OFFERING BOTH ENGLISH AND FRENCH IMMERSION CLASSES**

French Immersion programs are designed to provide non-francophone children with a high degree of proficiency in the French language. While any exposure to a second language is beneficial, French Immersion broadens and deepens that exposure. In addition to its excellent English program, St. John XXIII CES offers an Early French Immersion program. The September 2024 online application process for French Immersion will be open as of Wednesday, November 29th, 2023 for St. John XXIII CES.

A parent information night will be held on **Tuesday November 28th, 2023**, to explain its Grade 1 French Immersion Program, with online application available after the school presentation at www.ycdsb.ca.

Transportation will be provided to French Immersion Students living within the St. John XXIII CES French Immersion Boundary.



- Students in grades 1 to grades 3, residing 1.2 km beyond the school and within the FI boundary will receive transportation.
- Students in grades 4 to grades 8, who live beyond 1.6 km and live within the French Immersion transportation boundary will receive transportation.

** Students are required to walk a short distance to and from centralized bus stops **
